YOUTH BASEBALL & SOFTBALL REGISTRATION


Registration will be held at the **Civic Center**, Monday, March 17 and Tuesday, March 18 from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm. If you can not attend one of these sign up times, you may sign up at the Civic Center during normal business hours until March 25. Those who do not sign up by the March 25 deadline will be put on a waiting list and will not be guaranteed a spot on a team. At least one parent must be present at registration.

Children will be assigned to a league based on age as of April 30. You must bring a copy of a birth certificate. Players must be the age listed on April 30 to play in that league. If you can not find a birth certificate, you can obtain a copy at the Cedar County Health Department. T-ball is for ages 4 & 5; coaches pitch is for ages 6 & 7; minor boys and minor girls ages 8, 9 & 10; major boys and major girls ages 11, 12 & 13; senior boys and senior girls for all who will be enrolled in High School for the 2014-15 school year.

The fees for each league are as follows: T-ball - \$15.00, Coaches Pitch - \$18.00, Minor Boys & Girls, Major Boys & Girls and Senior Boys & Girls leagues - \$25.00. Families that have more than three children participating will only be required to pay the three highest fees. Everyone must pay at the time they register. You will not be allowed to register until player fees have been paid.

COACHES: Anyone interested in coaching needs to sign-up during the player registration times listed above.

A family must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 4. A family (household) making application to the Pool Trust Fund must meet certain income guidelines. Applicants will be required to show proof of income.
